An Act to prohibiting age discrimination within the public schools of the Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 5 of Chapter 67 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following sentence:-  
3           “No person admitted to a public school of any town shall be discriminated against in  
4 obtaining the advantages, privileges and courses of study of such public school on account of  
5 age.”
