An Act relative to crime victim funeral and burial assistance.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 258C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended inserting after the word “expenses”, in lines 18 and 19, the  
3 following words: ; provided, however, that \$5,000 shall be the maximum award for such funeral  
4 expenses and \$3,000 shall be the maximum award for such burial expenses.
