An Act relative to the Westford Home Rule Charter Act.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 9 of chapter 480 of the acts of 1989, as amended, is hereby  
2 amended by deleting the words “the cemetery commission’ and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following words:- a cemetery commission of five members.

4           SECTION 2. Upon the effective date of this act, the town manager shall appoint one new  
5 cemetery commissioner for a term of three years and one new cemetery commissioner for a term  
6 of two years.

7           SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
