**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court  
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to campaign fundraising for state representatives.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 6A of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out clauses (e) and (f) and inserting in place  
3 thereof the following clause:-

4 (e) a candidate for state senator, state representative, county commissioner, governor’s  
5 councillor, district attorney, clerk of courts, register of probate, registrar of deeds or any other  
6 county officer- \$18,750.

7 SECTION 2. Section 1 shall take effect on January 1, 2021.
