**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to host community agreements.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 94G of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
2 section 25 of chapter 55 of the acts of 2017, is hereby amended in the first sentence of subsection
3 (d) by striking out the word “A” the first time it appears and inserting in place thereof the
4 following words:- “Unless otherwise determined by the commission, a”.

5 SECTION 2. Said section 3 of chapter 94G of the General Laws, as so appearing, is
6 hereby further amended in the first sentence of subsection (d) by striking out the words “, but not
7 limited to,”.

8 SECTION 3. Subsection (d) of said section 3 of chapter 94G of the General Laws, as so
9 appearing, is hereby further amended by adding the following sentence:- “The commission shall
10 issue regulations governing host community agreements and may review, regulate, and enforce
11 any host community agreement under this section.”.
