An Act to add a compulsory death benefit to automobile liability insurance..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following:
- 3 Section 6: In addition to the automobile liability insurance coverage that is compulsory
- 4 under this chapter, additional coverage of no less than \$100,000 shall be available to the estate of
- 5 any person killed by the negligence of the operator of a motor vehicle regardless of the
- 6 relationship of the deceased to the owner or driver of the automobile. Said coverage would be
- 7 made available to any estate, which at the time of death of the decedent, was survived by a minor
- 8 child, a spouse, or dependant parents.
