An Act Relative to Mortgage Payments..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Ms Spiliotis hereby amends section 56 of Chapter 183 by inserting the following section
2	at the end,

3	A mortgagor shall not be required to pay a prepayment fee or penalty, or be have funds
4	refused by a bank for property insurance or tax payments, due to limitations set by state or
5	federal agencies for ceiling amounts held in escrow, for the term of the loan.
6	Residential real estate payments under the terms of a first mortgage including property
7	tax and insurance premiums shall be recalculated as needed.
8	The commissioner of banking and insurance shall establish regulations rules as deemed
9	necessary to carry out the purposes of this section. Not limited to emergency provisions and

10 unfair payments under the provisions of Chapter 167 of the Massachusetts General Laws.
