An Act ensuring access to health care services..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1: Subsection (b) Section 35 of chapter 118G of the General Laws, as inserted
2	by section 15 of chapter 61 of the acts of 2007, is hereby amended by adding the following
3	sentence to subpart (3)(a): "provided further that such reimbursable health services provided to
4	uninsured and underinsured patients who are subsequently determined eligible for Medicaid or
5	the commonwealth care health insurance program, established pursuant to chapter 118H, shall be
6	eligible for reimbursement for services provided six months prior to the patient's application to
7	such programs."
