An Act Relative to William J. Higgins, An Employee of the Town of Nantucket..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Section 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the
2	contrary, the Town of Nantucket, MA is authorized, subject to appropriation, to pay William J.
3	Higgins, an employee of the Town of Nantucket who was granted a military leave of absence to
4	serve in support of Operation Enduring Freedom after September 11, 2001, the amount of
5	\$29,539.41. This amount constitutes the regular base salary that William J. Higgins, would have
6	received as a town of Nantucket employee during his military leave reduced by the amount he
7	received from the United States as base pay for military service performed during the same pay
8	period.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
