An Act Establishing a Sick Leave Bank for Mary F. Keeler, an Employee of the Trial Court..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the trial  
2 court shall establish a sick leave bank for Mary F. Keeler, an employee of the probate department  
3 of the Springfield division of the district court department. Any employee of the trial court may  
4 voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by  
5 Mary F. Keeler. Whenever Mary F. Keeler terminates employment with the trial court or  
6 requests to dissolve the sick leave bank established by this act, the balance of the sick leave time  
7 shall be transferred to the trial court paid leave bank. Sick leave bank days may not be used for  
8 absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave  
9 bank as determined by the trial court.
