Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 118 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 29, the words "eleven hundred
- 3 dollars" and inserting in place thereof the following:—\$1,650.
- 4 SECTION 2. Said section 2 of said chapter 118, as so appearing, is hereby further
- 5 amended by striking out, in line 31, the words:— "fifteen hundred dollars" and inserting in place
- 6 thereof the following:—\$2,250.
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 7 of chapter 118A of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 8 amended by striking out, in line 6, the words "eleven hundred dollars" and inserting in place
- 9 thereof the following:—\$1,650.
- SECTION 4. Said section 7 of said chapter 118A, as so appearing, is hereby further
- amended by striking out, in line 8, the words "fifteen hundred dollars" and inserting in place
- thereof the following:—\$2,250.
