Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1: Chapter 138, Section 34C of the General Laws is hereby amended in the first line by inserting the following after the phrase after "... any alcohol or alcoholic beverages ..."
- or who demonstrates a visible and discernible level of intoxication to a law enforcement official that is detrimental to the to the general welfare and a threat to public safety,
- Section 2: Chapter 138, Section 34C of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking
 the following sentence "... by a fine of not more than fifty dollars for the first offense and not
 more than one hundred and fifty dollars for a second or subsequent offense" and inserting thereof
 in its place, the following
 - For the first offense a fine of not less than \$250 and enrollment in a youth oriented education program for alcohol abuse.
- For the second offense a fine of not less than \$500 and a suspension of driving privileges and licenses for a period of ninety days if applicable. In the event of a minor operating a vehicle

- under the influence of alcohol, a letter from the arresting police department to the automotive
- insurance carrier of said individual informing them of the offense
- 15 Section 3: This act shall take effect upon passage.
