- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting between the words "Whoever" and "knowingly in line 1
- 3 the following: refuses to provide his name and address or who...
- 4 Section 34A is further amended by inserting after the word "number" in line two the
- 5 words "or address" and by striking out the words "following an arrest" in line 3 and inserting in
- 6 its place the following: when stopped or detained for a violation of a general law, statute, civil
- 7 infraction, ordinance, by-law, rule or regulation may be arrested whether or not the offense or
- 8 civil infraction is arrestable and.
