The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act regarding breaking and entering of a firearm retailer, wholesaler or manufacturer.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Chapter 269 of the Massachusetts General Laws shall be amended by inserting the

2 following section:

3 Section 10F. Breaking and Entering of a Firearm Retailer, Wholesaler or Manufacturer

4 Whoever in the nighttime or the daytime breaks and enters any building in which a

5 firearm retailer, wholesaler or manufacturer conducts business shall be subject to a fine of not

6 less than \$5,000 nor more than \$10,000 or by imprisonment for not less than five years nor more

7 than ten years or by both such fine and imprisonment.

8 Whoever in the nighttime or the daytime breaks and enters any building in which a 9 firearm retailer, wholesaler or manufacturer conducts business with the intent to unlawfully 10 obtain a firearm, rifle, shotgun, machinegun or ammunition shall be subject to a fine of not less 11 than \$5,000 nor more than \$10,000 or by imprisonment for not less than five years nor more than 12 ten years or by both such fine and imprisonment. Whoever unlawfully obtains a firearm, rifle, shotgun, machinegun or ammunition by means of breaking and entering, in the nighttime or the daytime, any building in which a firearm retailer, wholesaler or manufacturer conducts business and who unlawfully distributes said firearm, rifle, shotgun, machinegun or ammunition shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$10,000 or by imprisonment for not less than ten years nor more than twenty years or by both such fine and imprisonment.
