An Act relative to the collection of DNA..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 22E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
2	Official Edition, is hereby further amended, by striking the first sentence and replacing it with
3	the following:-

4 "Any person who is convicted of an offense that is punishable by imprisonment 5 in a state prison, any person adjudicated a youthful offender by reason of an offense that would 6 be punishable by imprisonment in a state prison if committed by an adult, and any person who 7 was convicted of an offense which permitted any period of incarceration in a house of correction 8 as a penalty whether or not the person was so sentenced, shall submit a DNA sample to the 9 department within 1 year of such conviction or adjudication or, if incarcerated, before release 10 from custody, whichever occurs first.
