An Act relative to Criminally Negligent Homicide..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 30A. A person is guilty of criminally negligent homicide when, with criminal
2 negligence, he causes the death of another person. For purposes of this section, “criminal
3 negligence” is the failure to perceive a substantial and unjustifiable risk that is of such nature and
4 degree that the failure to perceive it constitutes a gross deviation from the standard of care that a
5 reasonable person would observe under the circumstances.

6 Whoever is guilty of criminally negligent homicide shall be punished by
7 imprisonment in a house of correction for not more than 2½ years and a fine of not more than
8 \$10,000.00.
