## In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act relative to subsequent convictions for assault and battery on a police officer..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 13D of Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following language:—A
- 3 second and subsequent conviction under this section shall be punished by imprisonment for not
- 4 less than 120 days nor more than 2½ years in a house of correction or by a fine of not less than
- 5 one thousand dollars nor more than ten thousand dollars, or both. A third and subsequent
- 6 conviction under this section shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one year in a
- 7 house of correction nor more than 3 years in state prison or by a fine of not less than two
- 8 thousand dollars nor more than ten thousand dollars, or both.
