An Act relative to the regulation of livery drivers..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting section 172I  
2 the following section:-

3           Section 172J. Notwithstanding section 172, employers of livery drivers shall obtain all  
4 available criminal offender record and juvenile data as found in the court activity record  
5 information from the criminal history systems board of all drivers prior to employment.  
6 Information obtained under this section shall not be disseminated for any purpose other than the  
7 evaluation of prospective drivers.

8           SECTION 2. Section 11 of chapter 9 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004  
9 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “vehicle” in line 1 the following:-  
10 including livery drivers.
