An Act relative to identity fraud..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 266 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 37E the
- 2 following section:-
- 3 Section 37F. Any business that stores personal identifying information, as defined in
- 4 section 37E shall, by electronic means, install basic security measures. Any business of offering
- 5 internet access shall post signs warning users to have firewalls or other security measures.
- Any person found guilty of violating this section shall be ordered to make restitution for
- 7 financial loss sustained by a victim as a result of such violation. Financial loss may include any
- 8 costs incurred by such victim in correcting the credit history of such victim or any cost incurred
- 9 in connection with any civil or administrative proceeding to satisfy any debt or other obligation
- of such victim, including lost wages and attorney's fees.
