An Act prohibiting certain conduct for sexual gratification..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1: Chapter 272 of the General Court Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 28I the following section:-

3 Section 28J. (A) No person, for the purpose of sexually arousing or gratifying the
4 person’s self, shall commit trespass or otherwise surreptitiously invade the privacy of another, to
5 spy or eavesdrop upon another.

6 (B) No person, for the purpose of sexually arousing or gratifying the person’s self, shall
7 commit trespass or otherwise surreptitiously invade the privacy of another to photograph the
8 other person in a state of nudity.

9 (C) No person, for the purpose of sexually arousing or gratifying the person’s self, shall
10 commit trespass or otherwise surreptitiously invade the privacy of another to photograph the
11 other person in a state of nudity if the other person is a minor.

12 (D) No person, for the purpose of sexually arousing or gratifying the person's self, shall
13 commit trespass or otherwise surreptitiously invade the privacy of another to photograph the
14 other person in a state of nudity if the other person is a minor and any of the following applies:
