An Act relative to the vacation time of a certain employee of the trial court..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, and in order to satisfy a moral
- 2 obligation, John J.
- 3 McAuliffe, an employee of the trial court of the Commonwealth, shall be entitled to 5
- 4 weeks of vacation, annually.
