An Act clarifying the removal statute..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 30 of chapter 208 of the General Laws, as appearing in the most
- 2 recent edition, is hereby further amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new
- 3 paragraph:-
- 4 The removal shall be ordered only if the Court finds that the removal results in a
- 5 direct benefit to the child which outweighs any detriment to the child, including but not limited
- 6 to, that resulting from the loss of frequent and regular visitation with the non-custodial parent.
