An Act relative to DNA requirements for adoption..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 210 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 3B, the following section: --

3 Section 3C. DNA Requirements: A blood relative petitioner requesting return custody of
4 child of custodial age who is legally adopted by a non-biological petitioner, in conforming to all
5 requirements of chapter 210, shall provide evidence of his or her biological connection to the
6 child in the form of a DNA test. The court shall require such test to be at the expense of the
7 petitioner in question.

8 SECTION 2. This Act shall be known as the Sarah Joy Act.
