An Act to Amend the Jaywalking Statute..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 18A of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by striking the last sentence of the first paragraph and inserting in its place  
3 the following:-

4           “Whoever violates any provision of any such rule shall be punished by a fine of twenty  
5 dollars for the first, second, or third offense committed by such person within the jurisdiction of  
6 the district court in the particular calendar year, and by a fine of fifty dollars for the fourth and  
7 subsequent such offense so committed in such calendar year.”
