An Act relative to the recall of elective officers in the town of North Andover..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1                   SECTION 1. Section 5-5 of chapter 8 of the charter of the town of North Andover  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the  
3 following sentence:- The Board of Selectmen shall, within three working days, give written  
4 notice by registered mail of the receipt of the certificate to the officer sought to be recalled and  
5 shall, if the officer does not resign within five days thereafter, order an election to be held on a  
6 date fixed by them at least sixty-four but not more than ninety days after the date of the Town  
7 Clerk’s certificate that a sufficient petition has been filed; provided, however, that if any other  
8 town election is to occur within ninety days after the date of the certificate, the Board of  
9 Selectmen shall postpone the holding of the recall election to the date of such other election.
