An Act relative to the election of the members of the board of public works of the town of Hopkinton..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. At the next annual town election in the town of Hopkinton at which the 3  
2 members of the board of public works are to be elected the candidate receiving the highest  
3 number of votes shall be elected for a term of 3 years, the candidate receiving the second highest  
4 number of votes shall be elected for a term of 2 years and the candidate receiving the third  
5 highest number of votes shall be elected for a 1 year term. Upon the expiration of their terms all  
6 members shall be elected for a term of 3 years.

7           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
