AN ACT RELATIVE TO COMMERCIAL REBATE EXPIRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 93 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 14S the following section:—
- 3 Section 14T. (a) Definitions. For the purposes of this section:
- 4 “Rebate” shall mean the return to a purchaser of any portion of the purchase price of a consumer good,
5 issued after the time of sale, pursuant to the purchaser’s submission of applicable documents.
- 6 (b) The purchaser shall be given no less than one year from the date of sale to submit applicable
7 documents for the rebate.
- 8 (c) Rebate documents shall be considered submitted the date they are postmarked if submitted by mail, or
9 the date they are received by the manufacturer if submitted by telephone, internet or other means or
10 transmission.
- 11 (d) Violation of this section shall constitute a violation of Chapter 93A and may be enforced under the
12 procedures available under said chapter.
- 13 (e) This section shall take effect on the first day of January next succeeding the date of passage.
