An Act requiring identification of food allergens in eating establishments..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

| 1 | Chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 48E the |
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| 2 | following section:-   |

| 3 | Section 48F. All establishments which serve food will be required to identify in English              |
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| 4 | the presence of ingredients that contain protein derived from milk, eggs, fish, crustacean            |
| 5 | shellfish, tree nuts, peanuts, wheat, or soybeans in the list of ingredients or to say "contains"     |
| 6 | followed by the name of the source of the food allergen after or adjacent to the list of food         |
| 7 | products offered. Said list shall be listed on menus or separate food allergen list readily available |
| 8 | to patrons and employees or posted in a location easily viewable by all patrons and employees.        |
| 9 | Food allergen list requirements may be modified by direction of the department of public health.      |
