Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 118E of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 17A the following section:-
- 3 Section 17B. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, prior
- 4 authorization shall not be required for any anti-hemophilic factor drugs prescribed for the
- 5 treatment of hemophilia and blood disorders.
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective upon its passage.
