An Act defining the term apprentice cosmetologist..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 87T of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “skin” in lines 6, the following
3 words:— “Apprentice Cosmetologist”, means any person who is 18 and is engaged in the
4 learning of any or all the practices of cosmetology and, while so learning, performs or assists in
5 any of the practices of cosmetology in a licensed cosmetology salon under the supervision of a
6 practitioner licensed in the profession the apprentice is studying. The apprentice may perform or
7 assist the licensed practitioner in any of the functions which the practitioner is licensed to
8 perform.

9 SECTION 2. Said section 87T of chapter 112, as so appearing, is hereby further
10 amended by inserting after the word “cosmetologist” the following words:— “Cosmetology
11 Apprenticeship Program”, means a continuous week-by-week supervised employment and
12 training program preparing people for skilled positions in the field of cosmetology.
