An Act relative to the federal protection service..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 10 of chapter 147 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 Official Edition,  
2 is further amended by the insertion after Section 10M the following section:—

3           Section ION. The commissioner may at the request of the Federal Protective Service or  
4 the Chief of Police of the Department of Defense appoint as a special police officer employees of  
5 said agency. Such special police officer shall serve for one year, subject to removal by the  
6 Commissioner and shall have the same powers to make arrests as regular police officers for any  
7 criminal offense committed in or upon the property, lands, buildings or structures owned, used,  
8 leased or under the authority of the General Services Administration or the Department of  
9 Defense.
