An Act further protecting public safety..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 131 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the 2006  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out Section 71 and inserting in its place the  
3   following section:-

4           Section 71. A person shall not, during the open season when deer may be hunted lawfully  
5   with a shotgun, enter the woodlands of the commonwealth unless said person wears in a  
6   conspicuous manner on said person's chest, back and head a minimum of five hundred square  
7   inches of clothing or material of a hunter orange color which meets such requirements as the  
8   director may by rules and regulations establish. This section shall not apply to any person  
9   engaged in waterfowl hunting from within a blind or from a boat.
