An Act relative to bullet proof vests..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 122 of chapter 140 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as 2 appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following new section 3 at the end thereof:—"Section 122C. Any person duly licensed to sell ammunition in the 4 commonwealth pursuant to Section 122B of this chapter shall be required to keep a written 5 record of the transaction, including the name, address, phone number and date of birth of any 6 purchaser of body armor, so-called, or any protective covering for the body or any parts thereof, 7 made of resin-treated glass-fiber cloth, or of any other material or combination of materials, 8 designed to prevent, deflect or deter the penetration thereof by ammunition, knives or other 9 weapons, as well as the serial number of said item and said person shall make such records 10 available to law enforcement personnel to aid in the investigation of any criminal activity."
