## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act providing for certain creditable service for determining pay ...

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	Notwithstanding Section 8 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, or any other general or
2	special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the department of state police shall credit Paul J.
3	Thomas a member of the Massachusetts state police with creditable service from September 20,
4	1981 to January 7, 1999 the period of time he was retired for disability for the purpose of
5	determining his pay. Within 30 days of the effective date of this Act the Massachusetts state
6	police shall pay the difference between the highest salary step for Trooper First Class contained
7	in the State Police Association of Massachusetts contract and the salary he has been paid since
8	his return to service from involuntary disability retirement.
