Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 24 of chapter 93 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, 2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:— The commissioner of banks shall 3 regulate that nothing in this section, shall be construed to prohibit a person, firm, corporation or 4 association regulated as a collection agency in another state or residing therein from 5 communicating with a debtor in the commonwealth under the following conditions:— (a) 6 Agency must be licensed and bonded in home state; (b) Collection to be done by interstate 7 means such as telephone, fax or mail; (c) Collections are on behalf of creditors outside the 8 commonwealth; (d) Agency registers with the commissioner and furnishes proof of licensing
