The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act relative to the retirement of clerk/magistrates, clerks of court, recorder and registers..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 32, section 5 (2) (a), as appearing in the 1996 Official Edition of
- 2 the General Laws, is hereby amended by inserting the following subsection: -
- 3 Subsection 5 (2) (a) (i). Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary,
- 4 the normal yearly amount of the retirement allowance for any member in Group 1, Group 2, or
- 5 Group 4 who is an employee of the Supreme Judicial Court who holds the position of Clerk of
- 6 Court, employee of the Appeals Court who holds the position of Clerk of Court, and employee of
- 7 the Trial Court who holds the position of Clerk-Magistrate, Clerk of Court, Recorder or Register
- 8 shall be based on their annual salary at the time of their retirement.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
