An Act to protect social workers..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 58 of Chapter 30 of the General laws is amended by striking the
- 2 fourth paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following new paragraph:-
- 3 "Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, an employee who, while in the
- 4 performance of duty, receives bodily injuries resulting from acts of violence of patients
- 5 prisoners, or children in his caseload or parents of said children, and who as a result of such
- 6 injury would be entitled to benefits under said chapter one hundred and fifty-two, shall be paid
- 7 the difference between the weekly cash benefits to which he would be entitled under said chapter
- 8 one hundred and fifty-two and his regular salary, without such absence being charged against
- 9 available sick leave credits, even if such absence may be for less than eight calendar days'
- 10 duration."
