An Act relative to pension reform.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006

 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the word "year", in each place it appears in
- 3 paragraph (a) of subsection (1), and replacing it in each instance with the following word:—
- 4 month.
- 5 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on the first Wednesday in January of the 2011 and
- 6 shall only apply to those persons first sworn into office as an elected official on or after that date.
- 7 SECTION 3. . Paragraph (a) of subsection 2 of section 10 of chapter 32 of the General
- 8 Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 50
- 9 and 51, the words "fails of nomination or re-election, or ".
- SECTION 4. Said paragraph (a) of said subsection (2) of said section 10 of said chapter
- 32, as so appearing, is further amended, by striking out lines 73-77, and inserting in place thereof
- 12 the following words:-

- the following circumstances applies: (1) that the employee has failed of re-appointment,
- 14 (2) that the employee's office or position has been abolished, or (3) that the employee has been
- removed or discharged from his position without moral turpitude on his part.
