An Act relative to National Guard benefits..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws of the 2004 Official Edition is
2 hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-

3 “Any member of the National Guard that has served a minimum of twenty years shall be
4 eligible for state pension benefits regardless of the type of service performed.”
