An Act relative to civil service preference for a certain firefighter in the town of Milton..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a son or
- 2 daughter of Robert Byron, who was injured in the performance of his duty as a firefighter in the
- 3 town of Milton, who passes the required written and physical examination for entrance to the
- 4 firefighter service shall have his or her name certified for original appointment to the firefighter
- 5 service before all other persons on the eligible list for appointment; but if more than 1 person is
- 6 eligible pursuant to this act, the names of such persons shall be certified in order of their
- 7 respective scores on the open competitive civil service examination for firefighter.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
