The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act providing for an early retirement incentive program for public employees..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 32 of the General Laws or any
2 other general or special law to the contrary, the state board of retirement, established under
3 section 18 of chapter 10 of the General Laws, shall establish and implement a retirement
4 incentive program for public employees, provided, however, that in order to be deemed eligible
5 by said board for any of the benefit options under the retirement incentive program, an employee
6 (i) shall be eligible to receive a superannuation retirement allowance in accordance with the
7 provisions of law upon the date of retirement requested in his written application for retirement
8 with said board; (ii) shall have filed such written application with said board.

9 SECTION 2. Each employee applying for the early incentive retirement shall
10 request and receive a combination of years of creditable service and years of age, the sum of
11 which shall not be greater than ten years, for the purposes of determining his superannuation
12 retirement allowance.

13 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on passage.
