An Act relative to a retired state police officer..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           1 Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 32 of the General 2 Laws or any other  
2 general or special law to the contrary, Lawrence 3 W. Finneran of Hanover, formerly a state  
3 police officer, who has 4 been retired under the provisions of Chapter 32 or similar provisions 5  
4 of earlier law, on account of injuries sustained or of the hazards 6 undergone in the performance  
5 of his duty, shall have his retirement 7 allowance increased to an amount not exceeding one half  
6 the rate of 8 regular compensation payable to state police officers holding similar 9 positions at  
7 the time of increasing such allowance, in the comparable 10 grade or classification, as  
8 determined by the personnel administrator, 11 occupied by such former officer at the time of his  
9 retirement.
