An Act relative to sales and excise tax exemptions for disabled veterans..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to  
2 allow disabled veterans access to sales and excise tax exemptions, therefore it is hereby declared  
3 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

4           Section 1 of chapter 60A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,  
5 is hereby amended by inserting, in line 101, after the word "disabled" the following words:--  
6 ;and who qualify for and are therefore entitled to display thereon the distinctive number plates  
7 authorized by section 2 chapter 90.

8           Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,  
9 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 312 and 313, the words "and has been issued a  
10 disabled veteran number plate under section 2 of said chapter 90" and inserting in place thereof  
11 the following words:-- ; and who qualify for and are therefore entitled to display thereon the  
12 distinctive number plates authorized by section 2 chapter 90.
