An Act Relative to Property Taxes and Senior Citizens..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	Section 5 of Chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is
2	hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
3	Notwithstanding other provisions of this chapter or any general or special law to the
4	contrary, upon acceptance of this paragraph by a city or a town, the board of assessors shall
5	annually reduce the property tax on the real property of a person who has reached his sixty-fifth
6	birthday before the fiscal year for which the tax is due, and have lived in the city or town for 25
7	years or longer, to the amount of tax due on the property in the fiscal year prior to the person
8	reaching age 65, if the person occupies the real estate as his domicile or occupies the same
9	jointly with his spouse.
