Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Clause third (c) of section five of chapter fifty-nine of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1998 Official Edition, is hereby amended in the third and fourth lines by

deleting the comma after the phrase "or principally for the treatment of mental diseases or mental

disorders," and by adding the following new words:— "or principally for the treatment of mental

diseases or mental disorders of persons committed to a facility pursuant to chapter one hundred
