## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act relative to real estate tax credit for person 65 or older..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	There shall be added to Massachusetts General Law chapter 62, Section 6(k)(9), the
2	following:-

3	(10) Upon request, in writing, by a taxpayer who is 65 years of age or older, a city or
4	town shall furnish the taxpayer a written record of the taxpayer's "real estate tax payment" as
5	defined in this section (k) for up to three prior calendar years free of charge to the requesting
6	taxpayer, but no city or town shall be required to furnish a written record without charge for any
7	given calendar year for which a written record has been previously provided except that a city or
8	town shall provide duplicate written records for a reasonable charge in accordance with
9	regulations promulgated by the Commissioner of Revenue.
