## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act imposing a moratorium on mandated benefits..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Subsection (b) of section 38C of Chapter 3 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting at the end thereof the following:
- Notwithstanding the foregoing or any general or special law or regulation to the contrary,
- 4 no mandated health benefit bill shall be reported favorably by any joint committee of the general
- 5 court or the house or senate committees on ways and means, unless and until the rate of increase
- 6 in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for medical care services as reported by the United States
- 7 Bureau of Labor Statistics remains at zero or below zero for two consecutive years. The Division
- 8 of Health Care Finance and Policy shall file an annual report with the house and senate
- 9 committees on ways and means, the joint committee on insurance and the joint committee on
- 10 health care no later than the last day of January for the previous year certifying the rate of
- increase in the CPI for medical care services.
