## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act Relative to Open Meetings of Governmental Bodies Without the Presence of a Quorum..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 23B of chapter 39 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after the sixth paragraph the following new
- 3 paragraph:—
- 4 A meeting for which notice is filed and posted under the preceding paragraph
- 5 shall not be convened in open or executive session unless and until a quorum of the
- 6 governmental body is present. If such a quorum is not present within twenty minutes after the
- 7 time stated in the notice, the members then present may convene in open session for the sole
- 8 purpose of scheduling a subsequent meeting of the governmental body, and shall not deliberate
- 9 any other matter. A meeting scheduled under this paragraph shall otherwise conform to the
- 10 requirements of this section.
