An Act designating the building of the State Laboratory Institute as the William A. Hinton Laboratory..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to  
2 provide forthwith for the designation of the State Laboratory Institute building as the William A.  
3 Hinton Laboratory, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the  
4 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

5           SECTION 1. Chapter 272 of the acts of 1975 is hereby repealed.

6           SECTION 2. The building of the State Laboratory Institute, located in the Jamaica Plain  
7 district of the city of Boston, shall be designated and known as the William A. Hinton  
8 Laboratory, in memory of Dr. William A. Hinton, a pioneer in bacteriology and immunology and  
9 former head of the department of public health state biologic laboratory. A suitable marker  
10 bearing said designation shall be attached to the building by the department of public health.
