An Act requiring that the Registry of Motor Vehicles be directed to issue distinctive motor vehicle plates for recipients of the Combat Infantry Badge..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the 16th paragraph the following  
3   paragraph:—

4           The registrar shall furnish without charge to owners of private passenger motor vehicles  
5   who are veterans, who have been awarded the Combat Infantry Badge, upon presentation of  
6   satisfactory evidence of such status as determined by the registrar, distinctive registration plates  
7   for one private passenger motor vehicle owned and principally used by such survivor; provided,  
8   however, that the surviving spouse of a deceased survivor may elect to retain such distinctive  
9   registration plates for personal use upon payment of the established registration fee for private  
10   passenger motor vehicles and an additional annual \$20 fee until such time as such spouse  
11   remarries or fails to renew or cancels such registration.
